**JANUARY 28, 2014**

**The Wizard of Oz by L. Frank Baum (1900):**

After a cyclone transports her to the land of Oz, Dorothy must seek out the great Wizard in order to return to Kansas.

**FEBRUARY 25, 2014**

**The White Mountains by John Christopher (1967) (Tripods book 1):**

The Tripods (huge, three-legged machines) control all adults' thoughts and lives. Will's time of freedom is about to end -- unless he can escape to the White Mountains to freedom.

**MARCH 25, 2014**

**The Penderwicks: A Summer Tale of Four Sisters, Two Rabbits and a Very Interesting Boy by Jeanne Birdsall (2005):**

While vacationing in the Berkshire Mountains, four lovable sisters share adventures with a local boy, much to the dismay of his snobbish mother.

**APRIL 29, 2014**

**A Wrinkle in Time by Madeleine L'Engle (1962):**

When an atomic physicist disappears on a secret mission, his son, daughter and their friend search for him, going on an interplanetary journey through time and space.

**MAY 27, 2014**

**Harriet the Spy by Louise Fitzhugh (1969):**

Harriet writes down everything about everyone. Then Harriet loses her notebook and her friends read the always truthful, sometimes awful things she's written about them.

**JUNE 24, 2014**

**The Alchemyst by Michael Scott (2007) (The Secrets of the Immortal Nicholas Flamel):**

Fifteen-year-old twins Sophie and Josh get caught up in an ancient struggle between rival alchemists over an ancient and powerful book.

**JULY 29, 2014**

**Mary Poppins by P.L. Travers (1934):**

Jane and Michael's new nanny arrives and introduces them to some delightful people and experiences.

**AUGUST 26, 2014**

**The Lightning Thief (Percy Jackson, Book 1) by Rick Riordan (2005):**

Twelve-year-old Percy Jackson is the son of a mortal woman and a Greek god. When his mother sends him to a summer camp for demigods, he and his new friends must prevent a war between the gods.

**SEPTEMBER 30, 2014**

**Walk Two Moons by Sharon Creech (1994):**

After her mother leaves home, thirteen-year old Sal and her grandparents retrace her mother's route. Along the way, Sal tells the story of Phoebe, whose mother also left.

**OCTOBER 28, 2014**

**The Saturdays by Elizabeth Enright (1941):** Four New York City siblings to pool their allowances so that each can do a special thing on successive Saturdays.
